

Johann Nefdt started singing as a young boy in the school choir of the Primary School Bredasdorp in the Overberg region of the Western Cape. Johann grew up in Skipskop, a very small village at the seaside near Bredasdorp, and when he was still a young boy the people took notice of his unique voice and he was always asked to sing something for visitors at their home. When he was a pupil in the primary school in Bredasdorp the teachers were very impressed by his voice and started using him in school concerts and was he also a permanent member of the school choir. He also started with piano lessons which helped him later on in his singing career.

At the end of 1969 the Nefdt family moved to the Tygerberg area in Cape Town and soon Johann was asked by the organist of the D R C in Kraaifontein to join the church choir. Later the organist used him on a regular basis to do solo's in church services as well as ensemble work. Johann now became a regular soloist at church services and special occasions and whenever there were special services eg at Easter or Christmas he was always asked to sing solo's.
